

CLARIFICATION TEXT REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA FOR VISITORS

As Nitromak Dnx Kimya Sanayii A.Ş. ("**Nitromak**"), the Data Controller; we hereby prepared this Clarification Text to inform you, **our visitors**, about the processing of your personal data as per the scope of the Law on the Protection of Personal Data No. 6698 ("**PDPL**"), the Communiqué on the Procedures and Principles to be Complied with in Fulfilling the Obligation of Disclosure and the relevant legislation.

During your visit to Nitromak facilities; provided that it does not harm the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject, your personal data may be processed on the basis of legal reasons that data processing is mandatory for the legitimate interests of the data controller, it is expressly provided for by the laws, the explicit consent of data subject, and that it is necessary for compliance with the legal obligations to which the data controller is the subject in accordance with the obligatory for the data controller to fulfill his legal obligations in accordance with the Law No 5201. on Inspection of Warfare Equipment and Industrial Organizations Producing Weapons, Ammunition and Explosives, Defence Industry Security Law No. 5202, Defence Industry Security Regulation No. 27601, Ministry of National Defence Industry Security Directive MSY 317-2 C, Regulation no. 87/12028 on the Procedures and Principles of Production, Import, Transport, Storage, Storage, Sale, Use, Disposal, Inspection of Explosive Substances Excluded from Monopoly and Hunting Equipment and other related legislation.

2. To Whom Your Personal Data May be Transferred and For What Purposes?

Your Personal Data:

- In Turkey- may be transferred to Suppliers for the purposes of execution/audit of business activities, execution of goods/service procurement processes, follow-up and execution of legal affairs and execution of supply chain management processes within the scope of services to be provided from suppliers according to the service contract between us; to Authorized Public Institutions and Organizations for the purposes of providing information and execution of activities in compliance with the legislation;
- In Abroad; may be transferred to Real or Private Law Entities for the purposes of execution of information security processes;

Within the framework of the personal data processing conditions in the 5th and 6th articles of the PDPL, by following the rules in the 8th and 9th articles of the PDPL regarding the transfer and by taking the necessary technical and administrative measures.

3. For How Long Your Personal Data Will be Stored?

Your personal data must be stored according to the time periods set by law or related legislation as a minimum. If there is no time set by law or related legislation,



then personal data must be stored for a reasonable period of time determined in connection with the purposes of processing, provided that it is limited and measured.

4. What Are Your Rights Regarding Your Personal Data as a Data Subject?

Regarding your personal data, you have the rights to:

- Learn whether your personal data is processed,
- Request information if your personal data has been processed,
- Learn the purpose of processing personal data and whether your data is used in accordance with that purpose,
- Know the third parties to whom your personal data is transferred, in Turkey or in abroad,
- Request correction of your personal data if it is incomplete or incorrectly processed,
- Request the deletion or destruction of your personal data within the framework of the conditions stipulated in the PDPL legislation,
- When you request the deletion or destruction of your personal data with the correction of incomplete or incorrect data, to request that this situation be notified to the third parties to whom we have transferred your personal data,
- Object to the emergence of a result against the person himself by analysing the processed data exclusively through automated systems,
- If you suffer damage due to unlawful processing of personal data, to request the elimination of this damage.

5. How You May Exercise Your Rights as the Data Subject?

You may submit your applications and requests regarding your personal data by completing the Data Subject Application Form on Nitromak's website (http://www.nitromak.com/basvuru-formu), and

- By sending it through a notary,
- With a valid identity document, Nitromak's "Via Flat Business Center Beştepeler Mah. Nergis Sokak No: 7/2 Ofis No: 52 Söğütözü Yenimahalle Ankara" by applying in person in writing,
- By sending it to Nitromak's registered electronic mail (KEP) address,
 nitromak@hs03.kep.tr, using a registered electronic mail (KEP) address and
 secure electronic signature or mobile signature.



Pursuant to the Communiqué on the Procedures and Principles of Application to the Data Controller, the following information must be included in the application of the Relevant Person:

- Name, surname, and signature if the application is written,
- For citizens of the Republic of Turkey- the Turkish id number; for foreignersthe nationality and the passport number or if any, the id number,
- Domicile or workplace address for notification,
- If available, the e-mail address, telephone, and fax number for notification,
- The subject of the request

The Data Subject must clearly and comprehensibly state their request in the application which is to be made to exercise their above-mentioned rights and includes required explanation about the right in subject. Related Information and documents must be attached to the application.

The subject of the request must be related in person to the applicant. However, if the applicant is acting on behalf of someone else, then the applicant must be specifically authorized in this regard and this authority must be documented (power of attorney). In addition, the application must contain identity and address information, and documents confirming identity must be attached to the application.

Requests made by unauthorized third parties on behalf of someone else will not be considered.

6. How Long Will It Take to Conclude your Request Regarding the Processing of Your Personal Data?

Your requests regarding your personal data are evaluated and concluded as soon as possible and within 30 days at the latest from the date they reach Nitromak. If your request is accepted or rejected by explaining the reason, our reply will be sent to the address you specified in the application, primarily by postal or e-mail, if possible, in the same manner as your request.
